General

Inhalation

If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.

Eye contact

Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Get medical attention immediately!

Ingestion

Rinse mouth thoroughly. Drink a few glasses of water or milk. Get immediate medical advice/attention.

Eye protection

Wear approved chemical safety goggles where eye exposure is reasonably probable.

Hand protection

Protective gloves are recommended.

Respiratory protection

Under normal conditions of use respiration protection should not be required.

Fire fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media

Water spray, foam, dry powder or carbon dioxide.

Fire and explosion hazards

No unusual fire or explosion hazards noted.

Fire fighting procedures

Fight fire with normal precautions from a reasonable distance.

Personal protective equipment

Wear respiratory protection. Wear protective gloves / protective clothing / eye protection / face protection.

Preventive Measures to contain emissions

General measures

Stop leak if safe to do so.

Environmental precautionary measures

Avoid release to the environment. Collect and dispose of spillage as indicated in section 13.
